**All entries will be required to return the signed liability releases for each person participating in your float. The release will be sent via email prior to the event and available on the day of. Your float will not be allowed to enter the parade without the forms signed and turned in **

Greeley Lights the Night Parade Rules and Regulations

- 1) All entries must have a display of lights on or in the entry.
- 2) The lights may be Christmas Lights, flashlights or other luminaries. Candles must have covers.
- 3) It is suggested that entrants decorate their entry to match the "Greeley Lights the Night" theme.
- 4) Please DO NOT stop at red lights. This slows the parade pace.
- 5) Nothing may be thrown or tossed from the entry. Items may be handed out along the curb. There will be a \$200 fine if anything is thrown off entry. You will be invoiced by the Greeley Area Chamber of Commerce following the parade if parade officials see your entry throwing candy/giveaways.
- 6) The GLTN committee must approve any crowd giveaways, other than candy.
- 7) The fee to have an entry is \$40.00. (Sponsors are exempt. Contact the Greeley Area Chamber of Commerce/Visit Greeley to inquire about sponsorship opportunities.)
- 8) Between 4:30 5:00 pm on the day of the parade, your entry must arrive at 15th Street between 8th and 10th Avenues.
- 9) Please be sure to have signage or a banner to identify your entry.
- 10) Please make sure you have gas in all vehicles.
- 11) Please use a forward motion while on the parade route. Do not stop for a danced number/music number as this can hold up the parade.

12) No jumping on or off floats when entry is in motion on the parade route.

- 13) Each entry MUST have all participants sign waivers before going down the parade route whether they are minor or adult.
- 14) If there is a blizzard or it is 10 degrees or below, the parade will be cancelled.

I have read the above rules and regulation and recognize that my acceptance into the Greeley Lights the Night Parade is based upon the adherence to these rules. I agree that our group will adhere to all rules and regulations as stated above.
