Three regional history museums showcase Northern Colorado's high plains history. The Greeley History Museum, 714 8th St., features 3-floors of engaging exhibits and a research center. Centennial Village Museum, 1475 A St., is an 8-acre open-air museum featuring over 24 historic structures, costumed interpreters, living history demonstrations, and various events. The Meeker Home Museum, 1324 9th Ave., is listed on the National Register of Historic Places and showcases the home of Greeley's founding family. 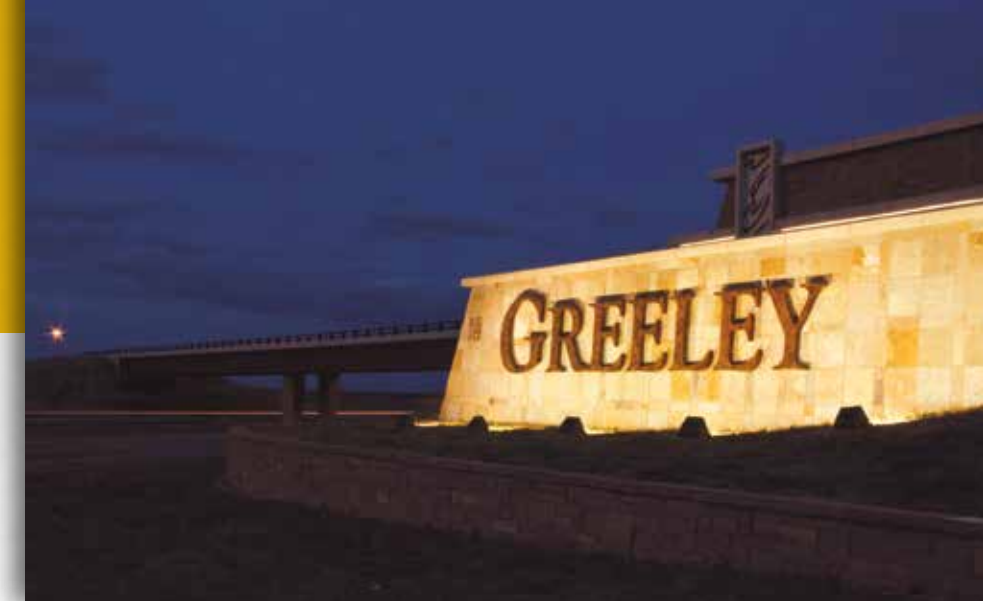
